

Message Notes for “There’s Room for More”

Romans 10:9-10 If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

Romans 10:9-10 As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame.”¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him,¹³ for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

- **Deuteronomy 12:28** Be careful to obey all these regulations I am giving you, so that it may always go well with you and your children after you, because you will be doing what is good and right in the eyes of the LORD your God.
- **1 John 5:3-4** This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands.³ In fact, this is love for God: to keep his commands. And his commands are not burdensome,⁴ for everyone born of God overcomes the world.

Romans 10:14-15 How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard?

And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent?

- **Matthew 10:19-20** But when they arrest you, do not worry about what to say or how to say it. At that time you will be given what to say,²⁰ for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you.
- **Luke 10:16** Whoever listens to you listens to me; whoever rejects you rejects me; but whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me.

Romans 8:17 Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.

Faith Group Questions

1. Review Group Expectations
2. Describe a time in your distant past or recent history when you believed you were saved by doing good things or by keeping God's commands? How did this affect you spiritually and emotionally?
 - a. Find at least 3 Bible passages that prove you are not saved by doing good things or by keeping the Commandments.
3. You heard some excuses in the message for why you might not invite a friend to church or talk to them about Jesus. Which one resonated with you the most? Was there a different one that you came up with?
 - a. Why is your reason(s) invalid?
4. Give at least 3 reasons why you would want to invite your friends to church? (bonus points if you give more).
5. You may have friends that will never accept an invitation to church. How will you bring the church to your friends?
6. Ask your group to help you pray for someone you know who is not saved.
